How Does it Work?

No need to sign up! Just add a few small steps to your routine!



Here's how the program works:

1 FILL UP WITH HARD-TO-RECYCLE PLASTICS
Fill the Hefty orange bag with acceptable hard-to-recycle plastics.



2 DROP IN WITH REGULAR RECYCLING
Tie up the full orange bag and place it in your curbside recycling cart or at an approved drop-off location, along with normal recyclables.



3 RENEW INTO VALUABLE RESOURCES
The orange bags are sorted at your local recycling center and acceptable contents are sent to a facility to be converted into valued resources.*
*Particular, valuable resources may vary by geography.
