



Sharonville's 4th on the Loop Parade Information & Entry Application

The City of Sharonville will hold its annual Fourth of July parade and celebration on Saturday, July 4, 2026 beginning at NOON. Our parade begins at the corner of Reading and Sharon Road in Downtown Sharonville and will follow the Downtown Sharonville Loop. This is your chance to be a part of a Sharonville tradition and celebrate our nation's 250th Birthday! Enter a float, classic car, marchers, mascots, musical groups, or performers into the parade. Our event is open to businesses, churches, local organizations, & individuals.

The lineup for the parade will begin at 11:00am at Park Montessori parking lot (3318 E. Sharon Rd.) for all parade units. This includes both vehicles and walking/marching participants. Step off will begin promptly at NOON. Participants who have walking units are encouraged to park in the public parking lot located behind Depot Square or be dropped off at Park Montessori.

4th on the Loop Parade Candy Distribution

One of the highlights of the parade is the throwing of candy by parade participants. To make sure candy distribution occurs in a safe manner, parade organizers request you adhere to the following guidelines:

- Vehicles are to always remain in the center of the roadway.
- Candy must be thrown as far away from the parade unit as possible. Do not throw candy towards the front or rear of the parade unit. A parade unit is defined as any vehicle, float or walking unit in the parade.
- Vehicle drivers are not permitted to throw candy. Candy may only be thrown by passengers of the vehicle.
- Parade participants under the age of 12 are permitted to throw candy under adult supervision only.
- Please always use caution when on the parade route. Be sure that all members of your parade unit are vigilant and can communicate with other members of the group.

The celebration continues afterward at Depot Square! Join us for fun, food, and entertainment immediately following the conclusion of the parade.
